Recent Laws

[Public Law 117-2, American Rescue Plan of 2021](#). CAAs and state CSBG offices can make sure individuals and families are aware of the benefits included and how to access them. Broadly, the law increases the Child Tax Credit, the Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit, Earned Income Tax Credit and includes \$1,400 recovery rebate checks, among other provisions.

[Public Law 116-260, Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021](#). Signed into law December 27, 2020, this provides for an additional \$22 billion in funding for states/localities to expand testing and vaccination efforts. CAAs and state CSBG offices can reach out to the respective partners to assist with these efforts.
